From the Pastor's Mail Pouch

Advent - A Season to Anticipate HIS Coming Ongoing Advent!

"Therefore, you also must be ready; for the Son of Man is coming at an hour that you do not expect." Matthew 24:44

The word 'advent' means "coming." In the Christian Church, the season which precedes the celebration of Christmas is called the Advent season. In it, we anticipate the first coming of the Savior, God's Son, into this world to procure our salvation by His innocent life being lived and then offered up for us on the cross to atone for our sin, followed by His glorious bodily resurrection from the dead on the third day. Such a series of eternally significant events began with Jesus' birth in Bethlehem, becoming a flesh and blood human being like you and me. Advent is a time to meditate, appreciate, and celebrate His coming to us to procure salvation for us.

Advent is also a time to anticipate Christ's <u>second</u> coming, when He shall appear to the whole world to raise all the dead, to judge the living and the dead, and to bring into its fullness the promised glorious kingdom of God with new heavens and new earth in which truth and righteousness reign supremely.

In His teaching about the suddenness and certainty of that day, Jesus used the days which preceded the Flood of Noah's day to indicate the magnitude of His coming again. It will be a fearful and yet awesome spectacle. There will be great weeping and wailing, terror in the hearts of those who are not prepared; yet there will be unspeakable joy in the hearts of those who know Him as their Savior and Lord. For this latter group, though small in comparison to the other, they will see Jesus their loving Savior face to face. They will touch His nailscarred hands. And, He will take them, in accordance with His promise, to their heavenly home, where there is no pain or sorrow or death anymore.

It is His will, clearly proclaimed in the truth of His holy Word, that you and I would be a part

of that later group: namely, that we would be included among the souls who are ready and found doing the faithful deeds that He has given us to do until He comes. When Jesus is "Priority 1" [the First Commandment], God's Word will take precedence over the busy-ness of this world's activities. We will be faithful to hear God's Word in worship, faithful to meditate upon God's Word at home with our families during the week, faithful to pray for His wisdom and strength, and faithful to bear witness to others of the hope that we hold in our hearts toward God regarding this life, the last day, and the experience of eternity with Christ. When God's Word is permitted to have a prominent place in us, God will accomplish this in us. For God's Word is always accompanied by His Holy Spirit, and He will work faith and obedience toward God in us as we hear.

WARNING: Therefore, do not become or remain so busy with worldly things that you miss out on God's eternal plan for your life: God wants a real and ongoing (and everlasting) relationship with you, reflected in worship toward Him, and prayerful dependence upon Him, and uninterrupted devotion to Him. His loving character will be developed during the time we spend with Him; it will be reflected as we put into practice His loving attitudes, words and actions towards our neighbor. For when God's love is truly in us, we cannot help but love and forgive and care for those around us. This is evidence of His work in us; and, it is evidence that we are ready for His coming. May that be so for you and me!


We would love to provide complimentary tickets for all the dads from the MN Adult and Teen Challenge program that would like to attend the Father/Daughter Ball.

Faith Comes By Hearing

More than half of the world cannot read. The majority of the illiterate population lives in poverty with few resources. Reaching poor and illiterate people from oral cultures with God's word requires unique strategies. Faith Comes By Hearing is based on the belief and evidence that oral cultures can more fully understand and live the Gospel when they hear the Word in their own language. Through Faith Comes By Hearing listening programs, believers are discipled, churches strengthened, new churches planted, and new converts come to Christ.

Currently, Faith Comes By Hearing offers 853 languages reaching over 5.7 billion people in 190 countries.

Offering every person on our planet equal access to the Bible requires meeting the unique needs of generations, technical societies, and fast-paced lifestyles. It also means meeting the cultural and literacy challenges presented when working in underdeveloped countries. Faith Comes By Hearing's goal is to record and provide Audio New Testaments in every translated language, making the fulfillment of the Great Commission a reality in our lifetime!

Through Faith Comes By Hearing's Military BibleStick project, our nation's troops are hearing the Word of God while on (or preparing for) deployment. The Military BibleStick is a digital audio player that is pre-loaded with a dramatized recording of the entire New Testament and over 65 minutes of selected Psalms.

Chaplains from every branch of the military are flooding Faith Comes By Hearing with requests. More than 485,000 of these Audio Bibles are now in the field. Over 1500 chaplains use Military Bible Sticks in pre-deployment briefings, counseling sessions, Bible studies, weekly chapels, and other spiritual services.
