### June Maintenance Report

We are hoping our June will bring some much needed warm weather and sunshine! The Esther Circle has purchased many of the flowers for the gardens and is watching the weather to plan for their planting! They welcome volunteers to help with planting and watering! Our gardens always look so nice and we thank all of them for their efforts!

Jim Carlson and Gary Lofald have been busy working to sweep the sand out of the grass. The two of them will be working on some of the yard work. Our plow person was able to get our parking lot swept and make some repairs to the ruts and also did some seeding for us. We are now looking at how best to address a few pot holes at the east entrance of our lot and also in the back near the soccer shed. We will need to redo some of the retaining wall blocks at the church and replace the edging along the sidewalk that holds in the rock.

We are working with MN Power to upgrade some of our electrical lines coming into the church. This will be done sometime in early June.

Gary G., our custodian, has been working hard to keep the church looking nice for us. Again, he is hoping to get the floors waxed here soon. He also pulled and filled the nail holes in Pastor's office walls and did some touch-up painting and gave it a good cleaning!

Pastor and Sue moved out of the parsonage on May 16. We are very thankful to the Allen family for coming over that morning to help Pastor and Sue with the final cleaning and getting the upstairs ready for pastors that come in to town to do our Sunday services for us. THANK YOU ALLEN FAMILY! A thank you to Mike P. for fixing the leak in the parsonage kitchen sink and to Gary L. for re-caulking the shower surround in the upstairs bathroom. They will also help move a couple furniture items upstairs. We plan to remove all the carpeting from the basement and will be looking into a different floor covering for the downstairs.

We also plan to repair the retaining wall on the east side of the parsonage when the weather gets warmer. We are always looking for volunteers to help with maintenance there too!

Many hands make for a lighter load so if you are available to volunteer for any of our projects, please, give me a call. We are so thankful that God has given us the resources to take care of all that He has blessed us with and also for our church members that have been given the gifts and ability to repair items when needed If you have questions or concerns, please notify me at 218-390-8357.
