Dear Congregation,

We have heard from Dr. Cary Larson. The pastor he was hoping we could interview for our Call has decided to withdraw his name from his Call list. Dr. Larson shared he may have someone willing to take an interim position with us. Mike will make arrangements to meet with this pastor and do an interview. Please continue praying for this to work out.

We were blessed to have 62 people in attendance at our church service on October 22. This was also the date of our Annual Congregational meeting which we held in Fellowship Hall following our service. Our budget of \$165,325 was passed. This is an increase of \$11,310.00 over last year. We have tried to build in enough money for our new pastor's salary and also for health insurance. We were also able to give Judi our secretary and Gary our custodian a raise as we were not able to do that for them last year. We thank them for their dedication and service to our church. Mike Pickar will be our new president. Carol Ziemer offered to help the trustees with counting. We thank them for stepping up to help. We would still like to have two more deacons and two more trustees on our church council. Please continue to pray for members to step forward to serve.

Our Wednesday Night Bible Study of the Chosen DVD series has moved to Sundays at 11:00 AM after coffee time to accommodate the needs of many of our attendees. We will adjust the start time as needed if the service goes long, please feel free to continue your fellowship in the blue room or the fireside room if you like. This DVD is only a portrayal of what the life of Jesus may have been like and we have all been moved, some of us to tears, when we watch it. We encourage you to stay for our Bible Study. The deacons will decide if we will have another Bible Study on Wednesday evenings. We will keep you posted.

We do have preparation in place for Sunday School and Youth Rap if we have youth come to church and would like to attend. We are thankful to Keith and Trudy Youngren and Mark Wiita for stepping up to help provide that. If anyone else is interested in helping with these programs, please let us know.

We continue to have our Food Share. We gave out 34 bags October 26. Our next food share will be on Thursday, November 16. We will give out items for Thanksgiving dinner and a \$15.00 gift card to be used to purchase a turkey. We welcome your donations and support of this mission. If you do bring a food item, please check the expiration date. We are not able to hand out expired items.

November Maintenance Report

Thank you to the Esther Circle for putting our church gardens to bed. We are trying to button up all that needs to be completed before the snow flies. We will be placing a *Memorial Gardens* sign on the back side of our electronic sign in the front garden in the near future. We have been blessed over the years to have memorial money to help with our garden projects. We will be putting the outside fountain and picnic tables away, too.

The new pump was placed on the boiler system at the parsonage and it had its annual inspection. We may need to flush the system. We are waiting to hear back from our plumber in that regard. We had the April Aire dehumidifier system installed by Basement Water Systems. We will be keeping the humidity level throughout the house at 50%. Again, this will keep the mold and dust mite spores under control and hopefully take care of the musty smell. We will also be replacing the ceiling tile in the family room downstairs as that may also be harboring some of the musty smells. We will also be replacing some of the fluorescent lights in there that are no longer working. We are hoping to get that done before the new flooring is installed. We are waiting for full flooring samples so we can approve a final color. We have repaired the thresholds on the front door and garage service door. We have also taken down the temporary wall on the basement stairs that was constructed for privacy when Pastor Carl was with us and we had the daycare. We would still like to get the inside garage walls painted; we will have to see if the weather will cooperate for us. The smoke alarms at the parsonage also had new batteries installed in them. The retaining wall project will have to be done next year. Thank you again to Grace and Wendy for doing the laundry and keeping the parsonage clean for our visiting pastors.

We have received three bids to replace the driveway at the parsonage to improve drainage by sloping the driveway away from the building. These will go to the trustees now for discussion.

The church boiler is scheduled the first week in November for its annual inspection as is the fire extinguisher inspection with the Duluth Fire Department.

Our Church Parking lot fund is still sitting at approximately \$13,000.00. The CD will come due in November and will be reinvested to add to our goal. Please keep an eye on the sign in our Fellowship Hall for updates. Our goal is to reach \$150,000.00.

The new can lights have been installed by Benson Electric! They have daylight bulbs and really brighten up the entrances to the offices.

Please note the beautiful shine on our Fellowship Hall floors. Gary Glad is in the process of waxing the floors for us.

We are so grateful to God for providing us with the resources to continuing caring for our church. We thank Him for giving our church members the gifts and abilities to repair items when needed. If you are willing to volunteer for any of our projects, please call or visit with me at church – many hands make for a lighter load. If you note something that needs to be addressed, please bring it to our attention. My phone number is 218-390-8357.
